Would anyone like to volunteer to continue the service which I have been providing? You don't have to **run** to Dowley Gap – you can go by whatever means of locomotion you prefer! If no-one approaches me offering to continue to take the drinks cartons from Wesleys to Dowley Gap (or another Council Recycling centre), then I intend to remove the cartons box from Wesleys by 17th July.


