A THIRD BIG DAY IN YORK MINSTER FOR THE BIG FUND FOR THE BUILDING DEVELOPMENT AT BAILDON METHODIST CHURCH.

SATURDAY 23 NOVEMBER

The first Big Day was pronounced 'truly memorable' by its leader. She said the participants 'felt a profound sense of the continuation of life ... where the very stones speak of worship.' The second was said to be a 'brilliant day.' I am arranging a third Big Day on a Saturday to enable those at work or secondary school to come.

A minibus takes the party from the library car park next to Ian Clough Library to 10 metres from the back door of York Minster. I lead a personalised guided tour of the Minster. I find everyone's name, or one closely connected with their family, somewhere in the Minster. After a lunch arranged at the Treasurers House for the group, but chosen individually from the menu, time is spent looking at the wonders of the newly reopened Undercroft, and the astounding new exhibition called the Orb about the world important East window whose glories can temporarily be seen at eye level. This leaves time for Christmas shopping and tea.

We need a party of 13, plus me, to get reduced group rates. The costs would then be, per head, £24 to cover the minibus and entrance to the whole Minster. As there is no Glaziers Tour on Saturdays, only £8 will this time be included for the Big Fund in the £24. In addition you will need to buy lunch - and tea if you would like some. We will leave Ian Clough Library car park at 0900 sharp and, departing from York at about 1700, get back about 1830.

If you would like to come, please let me have a £10 deposit **as soon as possible** to secure a place and give me your full names. Then let me have the balance of £14 by 20 November
