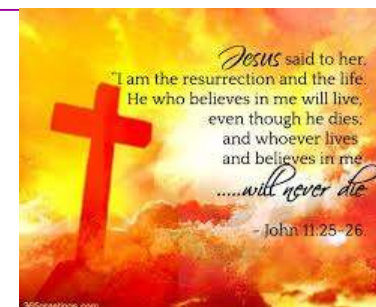

BAILDON CARNIVAL: SATURDAY 12th JULY AT THE JENNY LANE FIELDS.

Plans are well under way for the Baildon Carnival which will take place on Saturday 12th July 2.0pm – 4.0pm. Baildon Carnival welcomes stalls and activities from community organisations, churches, and local businesses. There is no charge for a pitch, but donations to Carnival funds are welcome. All donations are reinvested into the local community. Stallholders may sell goods and charge for games if they choose. Stallholders are responsible for erecting and removing their own stalls. These can be erected between 10.0am and 1.0pm on the day and must be removed completely from the site between 4.0pm and 6.0pm. Pitches will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis. Motor vehicles are not allowed on the fields; please park these responsibly and walk onto the site. The following products (which will be made available on the day through the Carnival Committee) cannot be served or sold on the community or local business stalls: hot food, ice cream, candyfloss and alcohol. Please do not include these in any stall.
